Executive Committee

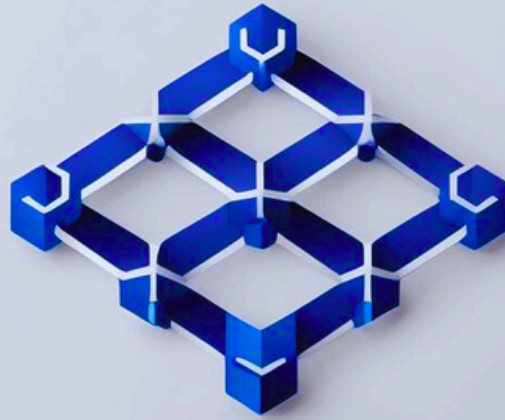
- Composed of the Director, Head of Research, Communications Lead, and Partnership Coordinator.
